What is an EHC plan?

An EHC plan is an Educational Health and Care Plan. The purpose of an EHC plan is to make special educational provision to meet the special educational needs of the child or young person, to secure the best possible outcomes for them across education, health and social care and, as they get older, prepare them for adulthood.

What does an EHC plan include?

An EHC plan should:



Consider alternative ways of providing support

Describe what the child or young person can do

Be clear and concise

Show how education, health and care will be coordinated.

Specify clear outcomes

Include the views of you and your child
