Staff will endeavour to talk to you at the end of the day to let you know if your child needed first aid during the day.

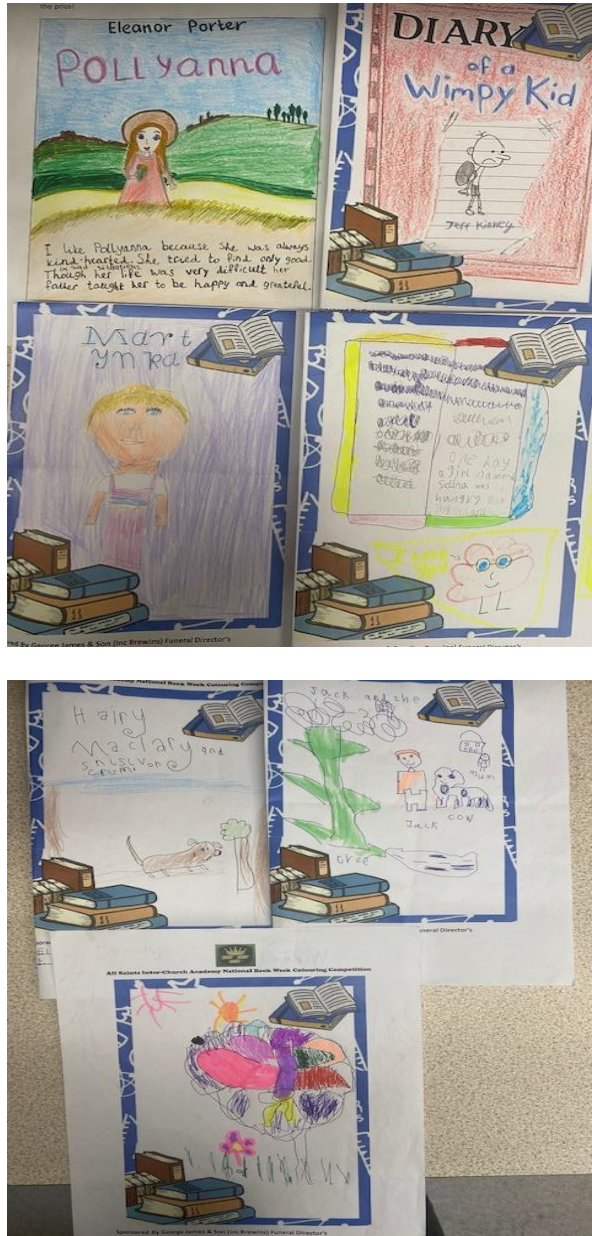
