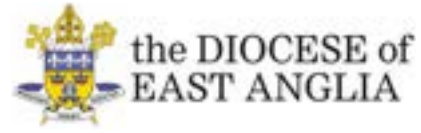

On Thursday 8th May, we commemorated the 80th anniversary of Victory in Europe (VE) Day. Year 6 paid tribute to those who sacrificed their lives in the conflict of World War II by attending a flag-raising ceremony held at March War Memorial.

As well as military representatives and local dignitaries, two WWII veterans (aged 97 and 102 years) were also in attendance, and Year 6 were able to hear the recollections of those who were actually there on VE Day in 1945.

It was a significant moment when we were able to thank these veterans in person, for their part in helping to secure the freedom of so many.

If you have any spare seeds or plants at home, or are able to make a contributions to our garden spaces we would greatly appreciate any donations. Thank you for your support.



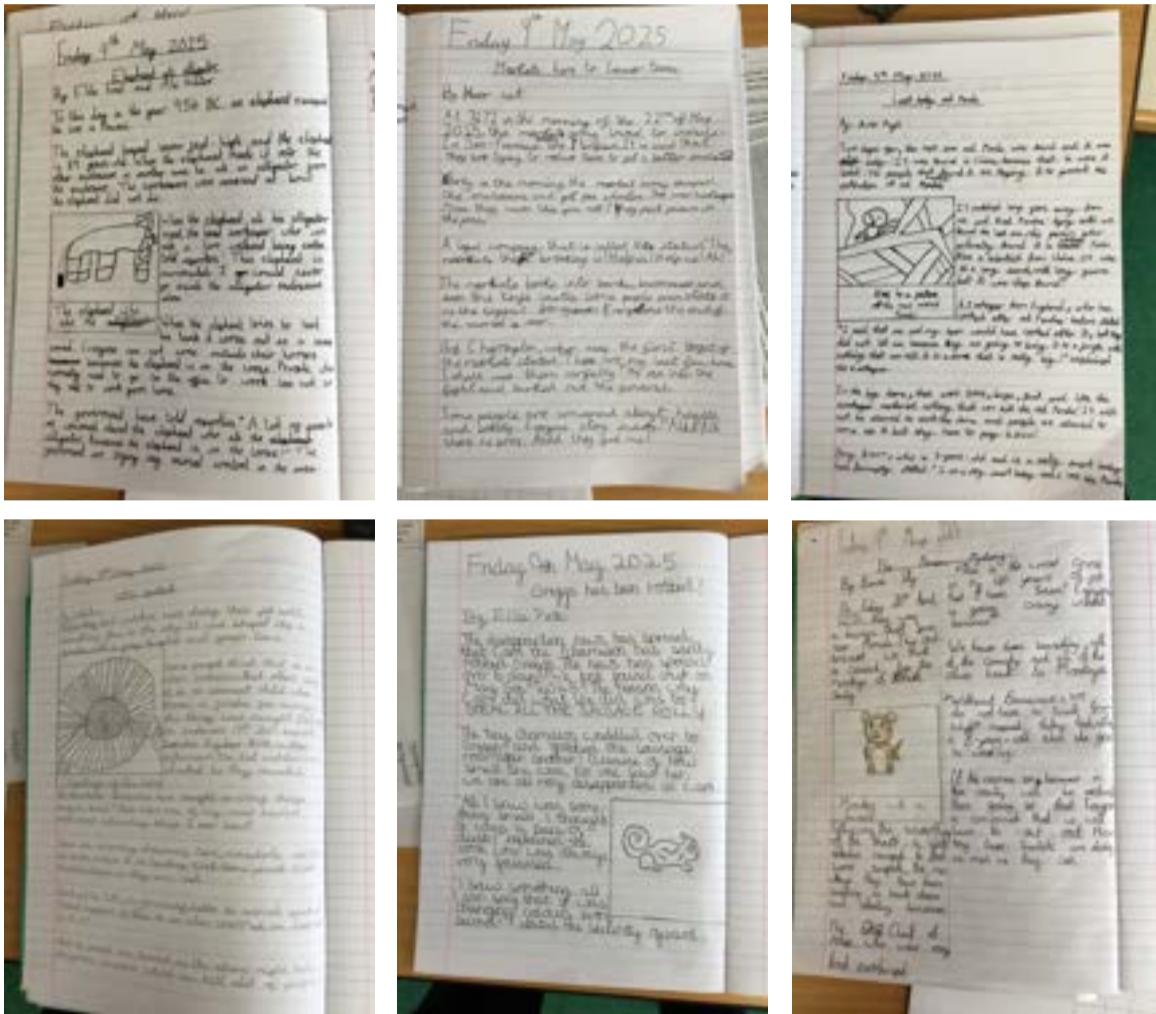
