# ATTENDANCE UPDATE

Thank you to all our families for continuing to support good attendance. This week, our figures show that while we've seen a slight dip compared to last week's excellent performance, we're still holding above national averages for the academic year—well done, everyone!

## This Week's Attendance (Week Commencing 24 June 2025):

- Overall attendance: 92.3%
- Authorised absence: 3.6%
- Unauthorised absence: 4.1%
- Total minutes late (whole school): 251

## Compared to last week:

- Attendance has decreased from 94.6% to 92.3%
- Unauthorised absence rose from 3.3% to 4.1%
- However – a big positive! Lateness has dropped dramatically from 998 minutes last week to just 251 minutes this week. That's a fantastic improvement—thank you!

## Why Every Day and Every Minute Matters:

Even small changes in attendance or lateness can add up over the term:

- Just 1 day missed per fortnight = nearly 4 weeks of lost learning per year
- Reducing lateness by just a few minutes a day gives children a calmer, more confident start to their morning

## Let's Keep Building Momentum

- Aim for a strong finish to the summer term with even more consistent attendance
- Support one another in maintaining routines and healthy habits
