FRIENDS Book sale and disco

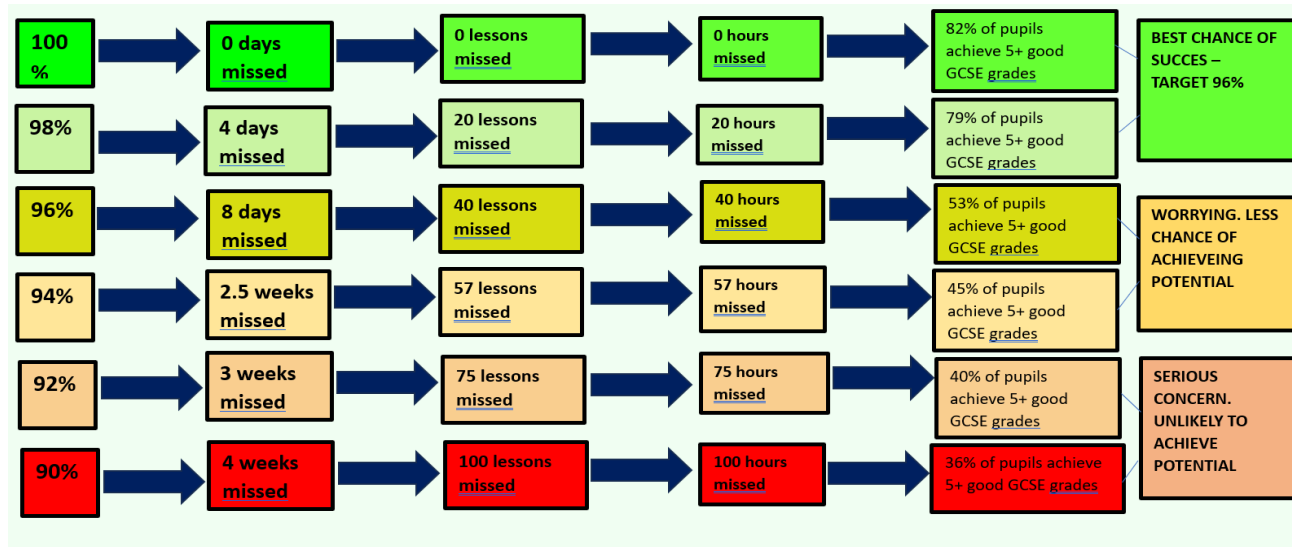
