As we settle into the term, we'd like to thank you for your continued support in helping your children attend school regularly. At All Saints, we know that every day counts — consistent attendance is key to academic success, social development, and emotional wellbeing.

So far this term, our attendance levels have been encouraging and reflect the commitment of our families and staff. Nationally, the expected attendance rate for primary schools is around 94.8%, with an average absence rate of 5.2% across the country

. We are working hard to ensure our pupils meet — and exceed — this benchmark.

What is emotional literacy support?

Emotional literacy is the ability to understand, express, and manage your emotions and the emotions of others. It's an important skill for developing self-awareness, self-esteem, and healthy social and emotional development

How can we help?

Sometimes children and young people in school face challenges in their life which can detract from their ability to engage with learning. Some children will require greater support to increase their emotional literacy than others. Emotional literacy support recognises that children learn better and are happier in school if their emotional needs are also addressed.


Mrs Davey is able to plan and deliver programmes of support to children who are experiencing temporary or longer term additional emotional needs. Support sessions aim to facilitate the child in developing new skills and coping strategies that allow them to manage social and emotional demands more effectively.

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
