Father in heaven

listen to the prayer we make in Jesus' name;

through the Holy Spirit's power,

gentle as a dove,

may this bread and wine be for us

Jesus' body and blood.

We remember that on the night he was betrayed, the night before he died Jesus had supper
with his friends,

he took bread and gave you thanks; he broke it and gave it to his disciples saying: Take, eat;
this is my body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of me.

In the same way, after supper he took the cup and gave you thanks; he gave it to them saying:
Drink this, all of you; this is my blood of the new covenant, which is shed for you and for many
for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.

Together we remember that Jesus is always with us and say;

All:

Christ has died.

Christ is risen.

Christ will come again.

So loving Father,
remembering how Jesus loves us, we can love him too.
You bring us closer and welcome us.
We pray together;

All:

Send your Holy Spirit on us and these gifts of bread and wine.

Help us to walk hand in hand with Jesus, help us to trust you, and bring us with all people into Jesus' glorious kingdom.

All honour and glory belong to you, Father, through Jesus Christ, your Son, with the Holy Spirit: one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

As Jesus asks us we pray;

Our Father who art in heaven

Hallowed be thy name

Thy kingdom come.

Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread

And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us

And lead us not into temptation

But deliver us from evil.

For thine is the kingdom,

The power and the glory,

For ever and ever.
