We also to walk the children on regular trips to the church and other local places of interest. All children will be included in both of these unless we are informed otherwise.

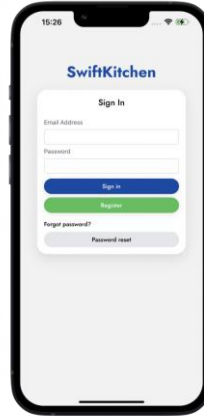
If your child has any allergies or intolerances please complete the attached form and return to school as soon as possible.
