Last week, our Year 4 pupils enjoyed a fantastic educational visit to Flag Fen, where they brought their history learning to life through a series of exciting Bronze Age and Iron Age experiences.

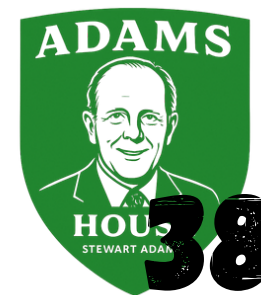
Throughout the day, pupils explored the ancient landscape, discovered how people lived thousands of years ago, and took part in a range of hands on activities. They learned about life in prehistoric Britain, handled replica artefacts, created clay objects using traditional techniques, and explored reconstructed roundhouses to gain a deeper understanding of everyday life in the past.

One of the highlights of the visit was meeting a historical character who shared stories about life in the Iron Age. Pupils listened carefully, asked thoughtful questions, and even had the opportunity to try on replica clothing and learn about the equipment and tools used by people of the time.

The children represented the school brilliantly throughout the visit. Staff at Flag Fen commented on their enthusiasm, excellent behaviour, and willingness to participate in every activity. Their curiosity and engagement helped make the day both enjoyable and memorable.

A huge thank you to the staff and volunteers at Flag Fen for providing such an immersive learning experience, and to all the adults who helped make the visit possible.

We are sure the trip will inspire and enrich the pupils' history learning for many weeks to come.

A huge well done to Year 4, who achieved an impressive 97.8% attendance, making them this week's attendance champions. Year 3 also had a strong week with 93.5% attendance, showing the positive difference that regular attendance can make.

Across the school, attendance continues to be strongest in Year 4 (93.5%), Year 6 (94.8%), Year 3 (94.4%) and Year 2 (93.9%) when looking at the year to date figures. These classes are demonstrating the value of being in school consistently and making the most of every learning opportunity.

We know that illnesses and unavoidable absences can happen, but every day in school really does count. Good attendance helps children build confidence, develop friendships and keep up with their learning.

Our challenge for next week is to see more year groups move above the 95% mark. With a little extra effort, we can turn more of those red and amber boxes green. Let's see if Year 4 can hold on to the top spot, or whether another class will rise to the challenge!
