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Year 5 and 6 Homework Information

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to a new term in Year 5 and 6. We would like to inform you about our homework expectations and how you can support your child at home.

This year, pupils will complete their **Mathematics** and **Grammar** homework online using the following websites:

- **Maths:** Maths.co.uk
- **Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling:** SPaG.com

Attached to this letter are your child's login details for both websites. Please keep these details somewhere safe, as they will be needed each week to access homework tasks.

This year, we also aim to develop children's vocabulary through the use of powerful words. Children will be given two powerful words to practise each week. They should practise using each word in a sentence, understanding its meaning, and learning how to spell it. They will be tested on how to spell these words every Friday. These will often link to a topic which are being explored in school. In addition, they will be given five high frequency spelling words.

All children will learn the same words to help develop their vocabulary. If a child finds spelling difficult or feels anxious about it, they will still take part by copying the words into their book, focusing on neat handwriting. This ensures that all children can participate successfully.

In addition, we ask that pupils continue to read at home with an adult **at least three times per week**. Please record each reading session in your child's reading record so that we can monitor and celebrate their reading progress.

If topic homework is set, it will be sent home to you in the form of a letter such as this.

Homework Schedule

- Homework will be set every **Friday**.
- All homework should be completed by the following **Wednesday**. This includes all reading books which have been sent home.



Completing homework on time will help reinforce learning from the classroom and prepare pupils for future lessons.
